

CLUB BINGO HOUSE RULES

Under NSW Community Gaming Regulation 2020

- Club Bingo is conducted on the registered club premises for the purpose of attracting patronage to the club's facilities.
- Total value of all prizes in any one game cannot exceed \$70.
- None of the prizes consist of or include money.

BINGO GAMES

- A session is defined as a period of time in which Bingo is participated.
- All players must be a financial member of the Club or signed into the club as either a guest of a Member or a Visitor
- No persons under the age of 18 years is permitted to play Bingo at any time. Minors may attend without playing and must remain quiet and be supervised by an adult at all times.
- The minimum purchase is (\$6.00 i.e. one book)
- No splitting/cutting of Bingo books allowed.
- Bingo books can only be played at the session they were purchased from and not used at other Bingo sessions.
- Club Vouchers or Drink Cards **CANNOT** be used to purchase Bingo books.
- The caller will announce the game format and game card colour before the start of each game.
- It is the players responsibility to play the correct Bingo Ticket.
- It is the players responsibility for altering the caller to claim their prize, prior to the next number being called.
- The player can only claim their prize when their winning game includes the last number called.
- The winning game and ticket must be verified by the caller before a prize is issued.
- Each number will be called twice and the number displayed on the board to be valid.
- If an incorrect number has been called and repeated, then that number will be deemed as called.
- For Minor games, once the Minor prize has been claimed, the caller will confirm the winner/s and continue to call for a Full House game and prize.
- When two or more winners occur for any game, the caller will conduct a game of chance to determine the prize winner. Each player will receive a random number and the highest number will claim the prize. Secondary prize/s may be issued to the other winners.
- Any decision by the caller is considered final.

CONDUCT

- All mobile phones are to be on silent or switched off during game times.
- Patrons are to be respectful of the comfort of others and remain quiet during all games.
- All Bingo purchases must be completed 5 minutes before the start of the first game.

GENERAL

- Due to Liquor Licensing rules and Health regulations, Food or Beverages are not to be brought onto the premises. Exemptions for patrons with specific dietary requirements will be at the approval of Club management.
- Impoliteness, disrespect, abusive, unruly behaviour or bad language will not be tolerated and said person will be asked to leave the premises and suspended from playing Bingo.
- Seating is first come, first served. No seat reservations permitted.
- Any person conducting or assisting in the conduct of the game cannot participate as a player.
- Employees and Board of Directors are eligible to participate in Bingo, unless they are working at the time of the session.
- Games, prizes are subject to change without notice.
All decisions made by Management are final.
